Key Dates for the Upcoming Month

- Feb. 27, 7:00 PM **Pre-assessment concert**. Students arrive 6:30. Features <u>CVHS Concert Band</u>, <u>CVHS Wind Ensemble</u>, and LMS Wind Ensemble. Dress is tuxedo/gown (WE) or polo (CB), black shoes, belt, instruments, music.
- Mar. 11, **Band Assessment** George Mason University.
 - 1. <u>Concert</u> and <u>Symphonic</u> Band students arrive at CVHS band room at 7:00 AM in concert dress polo, black pants, black shoes, belt, instruments, music. Parent chaperones will also arrive at the band room at 7:00 AM and ride the buses with the students. Return time is approximately 12:15 PM.

President

The Band Booster President oversees all of the booster activities. The biggest perk is meeting and getting to know the students and their families. The president works closely with the booster board and Ms. Hall. Additional responsibilities include:

- Create the annual budget with the Treasurer.
- Oversee the financial info/activities.
- Create the monthly booster meeting agenda and run the meetings.
- Organize food trucks for Bandemonium in May.
- Co-chair Tag Day in September.
- Help to serve dinner for band students at certain events such as the Pyramid Concert or end of season banquet.
- Help to organize the Band Scholarship application process in the spring.

Fundraising Chair

The CVHS band program cannot operate without the money we raise from fundraisers such as restaurant nights, car wash, Tag Day, Double Good Popcorn, and Krispy Kreme Doughnuts. It is vital that we fill this position before the end of the school year. Fundraising starts once marching band camp begins, one month before the start of school. If the title of Fundraising Chair seems daunting, we welcome volunteers who could be responsible for any specific fundraising events, such as the ones mentioned below. For example, one parent has already volunteered to be in charge of the carwash. Fundraising activities that could be managed as individual events:

- **Restaurant nights**: Responsibilities include scheduling fundraisers at Panera and Chipotle (done online 2-4 months in advance), advertising events, and ensuring the check is received from the restaurant (mailed to your house) and delivered to the Treasurer. Restaurant nights are usually August October.
- **Tag Day**: Our biggest fundraiser of the year! This event raises money for the entire CVHS music department (band, orchestra, choir). Though this is a large event, it has been running smoothly for years and the logistics are already in place. There are 2 chairs, so you could volunteer for 1 of them, and the boosters president would be the other chair. The event is held on a Saturday in September (date TBA) but all the prep work can be done from home. It is a large and important commitment, but also very rewarding as we make most of our school year budget from this one event.
- **Double Good Popcorn**: This fundraiser is super easy! It involves downloading the app, scheduling our fundraising dates, and advertising the event. This event takes place late Nov/early Dec. The popcorn is shipped directly from Double Good, so there is no delivery.
- **Krispy Kreme**: Duties include collecting orders for doughnuts, submitting the order online to the store, picking up the doughnuts from the store on the delivery day, and driving them to the band room before the last bell (3:00 PM). Fundraiser typically occurs in March.
- **Spirit Wear**: Advertise the store at the beginning of the school year (through this newsletter), place orders, organize items for each student, and deliver orders to CVHS band room when they arrive.
